
Consultation


Q1 1\. Do you think we need a pub in the village?


Q2 2\. How important is the pub to the village?


Q3 3\. How often did you use the pub when it was open?


Q4 4\. What did you visit the pub for?


Q7 7\. Would you like the pub to reopen as a pub or something else?


Q8 8\. If the pub reopened, would you use it?


Q9 9\. If the opportunity arose, do you think a co-operative run pub is a good idea?


Q10 10\. If yes, would you be interested in being part of the co-operative?


Q11 11\. Would you be interested in working in the pub?

Q12 12\. Which services would you like the pub to offer? (Please tick all of the following that are of interest to you)


